

# Application For the 2026-2027 College Academic Year Scholarship Fund

#### I. APPLICATION CRITERIA

Teamsters Local Union 222 Scholarship Fund will award scholarships totaling \$65,000 to outstanding high school seniors and Teamsters Local 222 members continuing their education. Up to FIVE scholarships will be given to Teamsters Members. Due to the great number of applicants to this program, all applications must comply with the following eligibility and application criteria.

#### **High School Senior applicants must:**

- 1. Be the dependent of an active and/or disabled Teamsters Local 222 member who is in "good standing" in Teamsters Local 222 as defined in Article X, Section 5 of the International Constitution.
- 2. Be in their last year of high school and may not apply if they have already graduated from high school.
- 3. Have a grade point average of 3.0 or better.
- 4. Be among the top applicants, ranked by GPA and ACT (or SAT) scores.
- 5. Plan to attend an accredited college, university or trade school for the 2026/2027 school year. If you need to defer your schooling, see Section V. in this application for qualifying deferrals.

#### **Teamsters Member applicants must:**

- 1. Be an active and/or disabled Teamsters Local 222 member who is in "good standing" in Teamsters Local 222 as defined in Article X, Section 5 of the International Constitution.
- 2. Be actively enrolled to attend or already attending a college, university or trade school for the 2026/2027 school year.
- 3. Submit a 500-word essay detailing your schooling and/or education objectives and how it will benefit you, your family and society. \*\*\*This is only required from Teamsters Members, not high school seniors.\*\*\*



## II. APPLICATION PROCEDURE & ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

## 1. High School Senior Applicants must submit:

- a. Completed Application (PART III).
- b. Academic Record completed by applicant's guidance counselor or equivalent high school official (PART IV).
- c. Official high school transcript.
- d. ACT and/or SAT results if available. (Highly encouraged to include results as part of the application.)

## 2. Teamsters Member Applicants must submit:

- a. Completed Application (PART III).
- b. 500-word essay, printed and included with application.

#### V. ADDITIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

ADDITIONAL RULES & REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE TEAMSTERS LOCAL UNION 222 SCHOLARSHIPS FOR THE COLLEGE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-2027.

Children of current employees or elected officials or the employees or elected officials themselves of Teamsters Local 222 are not eligible to apply.

Recipients must be graduating from High School during the academic year of 2025-2026.

A scholarship award may be utilized for tuition and/or book fees. Checks will be made payable to the school.

Recipients must utilize a scholarship award for the academic year 2026-2027 with exception of a qualifying deferral as outlined below:

#### QUALIFYING CIRCUMSTANCES FOR DEFERRAL OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

- 1. If the recipient is unable to attend college due to an illness certified by a physician, the scholarship will be held in abeyance for not more than one year.
- 2. If schooling is interrupted by military service, a religious mission or a service mission, scholarships will be held in abeyance for not more than two years, unless the mission or service is of such a nature as to warrant special consideration beyond that time. When returning from the mission or service, the scholarship recipient must notify the Scholarship Fund and apply for readmission within 90 days and return to school within six months thereafter.

Teamsters Local 222 reserves the right to review the Teamster parent's membership status with the local union at any time. Suspension from Teamster membership for non-payment of dues or for any other reason will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.

Any scholarship award not claimed by the end of the 2026-2027 academic year will be forfeited.
